

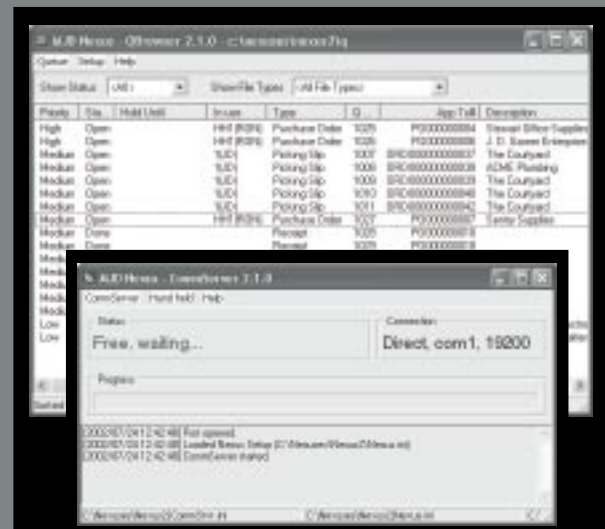
# MJD Nexus

**M**JD Nexus links applications running on hand-held terminals and their host application in an efficient, robust and automated manner. The Nexus system provides the necessary framework for communication and data management, to control and direct the flow of transactions back and forth between the PC and the hand-held terminal. Working behind the scenes, the Nexus system allows MJD applications to transfer data in a seamless way between a host system, such as ACCPAC®, and a hand-held terminal. The MJD Nexus is made up of four software programs: CommServer, Q Browser, Director and NexusSetup.

MJD Nexus is the link between MJD Portable Applications and ACCPAC Advantage Series.

- Communication link between the hand-held terminal and the host system

- Automates file management procedures of collected data files and hand-held databases
- Manages transaction flow by prioritizing and scheduling individual tasks

Transactions and/or databases are exported from ACCPAC Advantage Series™. ■ Transaction Q prioritizes and schedules transaction upload to the hand-held terminals. ■ Load the hand-helds using CommServer. ■ Process receipts, stock counts, orders, etc. on the hand-helds. ■ Download completed transactions using CommServer. ■ The Director then moves, renames, or archives transaction files for import into ACCPAC.
